AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III TRAFFIC CODE CHAPTER 380 SCHEDULE III AND REQUIRING ALL TRAFFIC TO STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF MITCHELL AVENUE AND DIGGS PLACE AND DESIGNATED AS A THREE-WAY STOP; PROVIDING FOR PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND SETTING EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF NEW MADRID, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: That all vehicles traveling on Mitchell Avenue come to a stop at the intersection of Diggs Place and all vehicles traveling on Diggs Place come to a stop at the intersection of Mitchell Avenue and that said intersection shall be designated as a Three-Way Stop and that no vehicle shall proceed through said intersection until it has come to a complete stop and all vehicles proceeding through the intersection have been allowed to go through.

SECTION II: That all persons violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined a sum of not less than one dollar (\$1.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment for a term of not more than thirty (30) days or by both said fine and imprisonment.

SECTION III: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after its passage and approval and all Ordinances in conflict herewith are, insofar as they conflict, hereby repealed.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III TRAFFIC CODE CHAPTER 380 SCHEDULE III AND REQUIRING TRAFFIC TO YIELD AT THE INTERSECTION OF MITCHELL AVENUE AND ALLEYWAY AT ITS SOUTHERN TERMINUS AND AT THE INTERSECTION OF CHURCH STREET AND THE ALLEYWAY AT ITS NORTHERN TERMINUS; PROVIDING FOR PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND SETTING EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF NEW MADRID, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: That all vehicles traveling east and west in the alleyway that lies between Scott Street and Riley Street shall yield to traffic traveling into the intersection of said alleyway from Mitchell Avenue and Church Street and that no vehicle shall proceed through said intersection from the alleyway unless it yields to all vehicles proceeding through the intersections of both streets.

SECTION II: That all persons violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined a sum of not less than one dollar (\$1.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment for a term of not more than thirty (30) days or by both said fine and imprisonment.

SECTION III: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after its passage and approval and all Ordinances in conflict herewith are, insofar as they conflict, hereby repealed.
