AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III TRAFFIC CODE CHAPTER 380 SCHEDULE III AND REQUIRING ALL TRAFFIC TO STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF MILL STREET AND KINGSHIGHWAY AND DESIGNATED AS A FOUR-WAY STOP; PROVIDING FOR PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND SETTING EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF NEW MADRID, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: That all vehicles traveling on Mill Street come to a stop at the intersection of Kingshighway and all vehicles traveling on Kingshighway come to a stop at the intersection of Mill Street and that said intersection shall be designated as a Four-Way Stop and that no vehicle shall proceed through said intersection until it has come to a complete stop and all vehicles proceeding through the intersection have been allowed to go through.

SECTION II: That all persons violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined a sum of not less than one dollar (\$1.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment for a term of not more than thirty (30) days or by both said fine and imprisonment.

SECTION III: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval and all Ordinances in conflict herewith are, insofar as they conflict, hereby repealed.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III TRAFFIC CODE CHAPTER 380 SCHEDULE VII AND REQUIRING TRAFFIC TO YEILD AT THE INTERSECTION OF MAIN STREET AND THE LEVEE ROAD AND AT THE INTERSECTION OF CAPITOL STREET; PROVIDING FOR PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND SETTING EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF NEW MADRID, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: That all vehicles traveling south on Main Street shall yield to traffic traveling into the intersection on the Levee Road and that no vehicle shall proceed through said intersection from Main Street unless it yields to all vehicles proceeding through the intersection and all vehicles traveling south on Capitol Street shall yield to traffic traveling into the intersection on the Levee Road and that no vehicle shall proceed though said intersection from Capitol Street unless it yields to all vehicles proceeding through the intersection.

SECTION II: That all persons violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined a sum of not less than one dollar (\$1.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment for a term of not more than thirty (30) days or by both said fine and imprisonment.

SECTION III: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after its passage and approval and all Ordinances in conflict herewith are, insofar as they conflict, hereby repealed.
